For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the dispositive portion of the Decision of the Second Division dated 26 March 2010, in Administrative Case No. 5768, entitled "**Atty. Bonifacio T. Barandon, Jr. vs. Atty. Edwin Z. Ferrer, Sr.**", to wit:

"**ACCORDINGLY**, the Court **AFFIRMS** the May 22, 2008 Resolution of the IBP Board of Governors in CBD Case 01-809 and **ORDERS** the suspension of Atty. Edwin Z. Ferrer, Sr. from the practice of law for one year effective upon his receipt of this Decision."

In a Resolution dated 21 July 2010, the Court **DENIED** with **FINALITY** the respondent's motion for reconsideration thereof for lack of substantial merit. Respondent received said Decision on 12 May 2010 per Registry Return Receipt No. 40955.
