
SUBJECT: INVENTORY ON CONVICTION AND ITS SANCTION OF CHILDREN  
IN CONFLICT WITH THE LAW

In compliance with the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child, the Philippine government must submit a report on the following data: number of children in conflict with the law (CICL) who have been, since the implementation of the Act, convicted for a criminal offense and its corresponding sanction. The Juvenile Justice and Welfare Council (JJWC) is mandated to ensure the implementation of the Juvenile Justice and Welfare Act (Republic Act 9344).

In order for the JJWC to prepare the required report, you are hereby directed to submit the needed data every 10<sup>th</sup> day of January and every 10<sup>th</sup> day of July of each year direct to the Juvenile Justice and Welfare Council, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor DOJ Agencies Building, NIA Road, Diliman 1100 Quezon City, Metro Manila, copy furnished the Office of the Court Administrator.

The first report must be submitted on or before January 10, 2010 using the attached form.
