SUSPENSION OF ATTY. JESUS T. ALBACITE FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW

For the information and guidance of all concerned, quoted hereunder is the resolution of the Third Division of this Court dated May 29, 1990 in Administrative Case No. 2808 (Sabina L. Morales vs. Atty. Jesus T. Albacite) suspending Atty. Jesus T. Albacite from the practice of law for a period of six (6) months, to wit:

"Administrative Case No. 2808 (Sabina L. Morales vs. Atty. Jesus T. Albacite).—
Considering the report and recommendation of the Solicitor General, dated March 29, 1990, the Court Resolved: 1) to APPROVE the recommendation that respondent Albacite be adjudged guilty of negligence of his duty to his client, complainant herein, for failure to submit the required brief in the appeal of his client within the reglementary period, and to take the proper steps to reinstate his client's appeal, and 2) to IMPOSE upon respondent Jesus T. Albacite a penalty of SUSPENSION from the practice of law for a period of six (6) months."
