SUBJECT: PERMANENT DISQUALIFICATION FROM BEING COMMISSIONED AS NOTARY PUBLIC OF ATTY. RAMONCITO B. BAYLOSIS


For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the Decision dated 24 January 2017 of the Court *En Banc* in Administrative Case No. 11545, entitled "Susan Loberes-Pintal v. Atty. Ramoncito B. Baylosis," to wit:

WHEREFORE, finding Atty. Ramoncito B. Baylosis GUILTY of violating the Rule on Notarial Practice and Rule 1.01 and Canon 1 of the Code of Professional Responsibility, the Court hereby imposes the penalty of being PERMANENTLY BARRED from being commissioned as a Notary Public with a STERN WARNING that repetition of the same or similar conduct in the future will be dealt with more severely.

This order is IMMEDIATELY EXECUTORY.

In a Resolution dated 20 June 2017, the Court CONSIDERED AS SERVED the Notice of Judgment and Resolution sent to complainant and respondent which were returned unserved.
