SUSPENSION OF ATTY. MARLON B. MERCADO FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW FOR SIX (6) MONTHS AND REVOCATION OF HIS NOTARIAL COMMISSION AND DISQUALIFICATION FROM REAPPOINTMENT AS NOTARY PUBLIC FOR ONE (1) YEAR

For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the dispositive portion of the Resolution dated 7 August 2019 of the First Division in Administrative Case No. 11141, entitled "Eleanor C. Escobar vs. Atty. Marlon B. Mercado," to wit:

WHEREFORE, respondent Atty. Marlon Mercado is GUILTY of violating the 2004 Rules on Practice and the Code of Professional Responsibility. His notarial commission, if still existing, is hereby REVOKED, and he is hereby DISQUALIFIED from reappointment as Notary Public for a period of one (1) year. He is likewise SUSPENDED from the practice of law for six (6) months effective immediately. Further, he is WARNED that a repetition of the same or similar acts in the future shall be dealt with more severely. He is DIRECTED to report the date of his receipt of this Resolution to enable this Court to determine when his suspension shall take effect.

Let a copy of this Resolution be attached to the personal records of Atty. Marlon B. Mercado in the Office of the Bar Confidant and copies thereof be furnished the courts and the Integrated Bar of the Philippines.

In his manifestation and compliance dated 12 September 2019, respondent stated that he received a copy of the aforesaid Resolution on 11 September 2019.
