SUSPENSION OF ATTY. CORAZON C. CHAVEZ FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW FOR SIX (6) MONTHS

For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the dispositive portion of the Resolution dated 26 June 2019 of the Second Division in Administrative Case No. 11506, entitled "Lorenza Vasquez vs. Atty. Corazon C. Chavez," to wit:

WHEREFORE, finding the recommendation of the Board of Governors of the Integrated Bar of the Philippines to be fully supported by the evidence on record and applicable laws, the Court RESOLVES to SUSPEND Atty. Corazon C. Chavez from the practice of law for a period of six (6) months to commence immediately upon receipt of this Resolution for violation of Rules 1.01 and 7.03 of the Code of Professional Responsibility.

Atty. Chavez is DIRECTED to report within five (5) days from notice the date of his receipt of this Resolution to enable this Court to determine when his suspension shall take effect.

Let a copy of this Resolution be entered in Atty. Chavez's record as a member of the Bar, and notice served on the Integrated Bar of the Philippines and on the Office of the Court Administrator for circulation to all courts in the country.
