SUBJECT: LIFTING OF SUSPENSION FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW OF ATTY. CORAZON S. AGUSTIN-ONGBUECO

For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the Resolution dated 9 September 2019 of the Special Third Division in Administrative Case No. 7317, entitled "Dandy V. Quijano vs. Atty. Corazon S. Agustin-Ongbueco," to wit:

Acting on respondent Atty. Corazon S. Agustin-Ongbueco's Compliance and Manifestation dated January 30, 2019, with the Resolution dated July 2, 2018, submitting to the Court the certifications from the court where she practices her legal profession, attesting that she has refrained from the practice of law during the period of her suspension; and considering the Office of the Bar Confidant's Report and Recommendation dated February 11, 2019 submitting that based on the records and documents submitted, respondent has fully served her three-month suspension from the practice of law from November 23, 2017 until February 23, 2018, the Court resolves to:

(1) **NOTE** said compliance and manifestation; and

(2) LIFT the order of suspension imposed against Atty. Corazon S. Agustin-[Ongbueco] in the Resolution dated July 19, 2017, and ALLOW her to RESUME practice of law.
