For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the Resolution dated 19 June 2019 of the Special Third Division in Administrative Case No. 10553, entitled "Filipinas O. Celedonio vs. Atty. Jaime F. Estrabillo," to wit:


The Court NOTES respondent's Compliance and Motion to Lift Order of Suspension dated October 15, 2018 with the Resolution dated July 2, 2018 submitting certifications from the Integrated Bar of the Philippines, Pampanga Chapter and from the courts where he had practiced his profession prior to his suspension, affirming that respondent has ceased and desisted from the practice of law and has not appeared in court as counsel from September 5, 2017 to March 5, 2018.


Acting on the Report and Recommendation dated November 8, 2018 of the Office of the Bar Confidant (OBC) and considering the above-mentioned compliance and motion to lift order of suspension of the respondent, the Court, upon the recommendation of the OBC, resolves to LIFT the order of suspension from the practice of law imposed upon respondent and ALLOW him to RESUME his law practice.

The said report and recommendation of the OBC is NOTED.

Case is considered CLOSED and TERMINATED.
