SUBJECT : SUSPENSION OF ATTY. PRUDENCIO S. PENTICOSTES FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW.

For the information and guidance of all concerned, quoted hereunder is the pertinent portion of the Court En Banc resolution promulgated on September 28, 1990, in Adm. Matter Nos. RTJ-89-331, RTJ-89-355, RTJ-89-361, RTJ-89-362, RTJ-89-438, and RTJ-89-439 entitled "Prudencio S. Penticostes vs. Judge Rafael Hidalgo", to wit:


"Wherefore, having found the charges above-mentioned to be absolutely without basis, the Court Resolved to:

"x x x x x

"(3) SUSPEND complainant from the practice of law for one (1) year for his willful disregard and disobedience of the admonition made by the Court in RTJ-89-294, and his violation of Canons 10, 11 and 12 of the Code of Professional Responsibility, with a stern warning that a repetition of the same will be dealt with more severely. The suspension shall take effect from the date of receipt of this Resolution. x x x"
