SUBJECT : INDIRECT CONTEMPT AND FINE OF MR. REMBERTO C. KARA-AN, SR.

For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the Resolution dated 7 June 2017 of the Third Division in A.M. No. MTJ-07-1674 entitled "**Remberto C. Kara-an, Sr. v. Judge Francisco S. Lindo, Metropolitan Trial Court [MeTC], Branch 55, Malabon City, Judge Edison F. Quintin, MeTC, Branch 56, Malabon City, and Ma. Fe Brenda J. Travino, Branch Clerk of Court, MeTC, Branch 55, Malabon City**)," to wit:

WHEREFORE, we find **REMBERTO C. KARA-AN, SR. GUILTY** of Indirect Contempt under Section 3(e), Rule 71 of the Rules of Court and impose upon him a **FINE** in the total amount of P78,000.00.


Remberto C. Kara-an, Sr. is **DIRECTED** to **PAY THE FINE** before the Cash Division, Financial Management Office, Office of the Court Administrator, within 30 days from receipt of this Resolution.



In the event Remberto C. Kara-an, Sr. fails to pay the fine within the 30-day period, the Docket and Clearance Division, Office of the Court

Administrator, is **DIRECTED** to report said non-payment to the Court.

Remberto C. Kara-an, Sr. is **ENJOINED** to refrain from further appearing before the courts and practicing law.
