SUBJECT : LIFTING THE ORDER OF DISQUALIFICATION FROM BEING COMMISSIONED AS NOTARY PUBLIC OF ATTY. DOMINICA L. AGNO

For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the Resolution dated 1 April 2019 of the Special First Division in Administrative Case No. 10689, entitled "Romeo Almario vs. Atty. Dominica L. Agno," to wit:

The Court resolves to *NOTE* the respondent's manifestation and compliance dated October 15, 2018 informing the Court of her last notarization done on February 5, 2018 and of her resumption on April 8, 2018, with application for Certification that she no longer has pending administrative case, to be used for the renewal of her notarial commission.

The Court further resolves to *LIFT* the order of disqualification of respondent from notarial act and to *ALLOW* her to file a petition for renewal of her notarial commission before a commissioning court of jurisdiction.

The Report dated March 21, 2019 of the Office of the Bar Confidant is *NOTED*.
