OCA CIRCULAR NO. 209-2019

SUBJECT : SUSPENSION OF ATTY. VINCENZO NONATO M. TAGGUEG FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW FOR THREE (3) MONTHS

For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the Resolution dated 17 July 2019 of the First Division in Administrative Case No. 12422, entitled "Roberto J. Delloro vs. Atty. Vincenzo Nonato M. Taggweg," to wit:

Considering that the findings of fact and recommendation of the Investigating Commissioner in the attached report and recommendation, as approved by the IBP Board of Governors, are supported by the evidence on record and applicable laws, the Court **ADOPTS** and **ACCEPTS** these findings and recommendation finding Atty. Vincenzo Nonato M. Taggweg guilty of violating his Lawyer's Oath and Rule 16.04, Canon 16 of the Code of Professional Responsibility such that respondent is meted the penalty of **SUSPENSION FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW** for a period of **THREE (3) MONTHS** with a **STERN WARNING** that commission of the same or similar acts shall be dealt with more severely. Respondent is likewise **ORDERED** to pay in full the remaining amount of his outstanding loan to complainant in three (3) months.


The Indorsement dated June 6, 2019 of Director Marlou B. Urbano, Integrated Bar of the Philippines' Commission on Bar Discipline, forwarding the thereto attached motion for execution filed [by] the complainant; and the complainant's motion for execution dated May 30, 2019, through counsel, praying that the resolution of

the Integrated Bar of the Philippines suspending respondent be now implemented, are both NOTED.
