For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the dispositive portion of the Resolution dated 19 March 2019 of the Court *En Banc* in Administrative Case No. 8124, entitled "Atty. Ferdinand S. Agustin vs. Atty. Domingo C. Laeno, Atty. Romeo R. Robiso, Atty. Reginaldo D. Bergado," to wit:

WHEREFORE, Atty. Domingo C. Laeno is hereby **SUSPENDED** from the practice of law for five (5) years. For insufficiency of Evidence, the case against Atty. Romeo R. Robiso is hereby **DISMISSED**.
