SUBJECT: DISBARMENT OF ATTY. ELIGIO P. MALLARI

For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the dispositive portion of the Decision dated 15 October 2019 of the Court *En Banc* in A.C. No. 12486, titled "Antonio X. Genato vs. Atty. Eligio P. Mallari," to wit:

WHEREFORE, respondent Atty. Eligio Mallari is found **GUILTY** of violation of **Rule 10.03, Canon 10, Rule 11.05, Canon 11, and Rule 12.04, Canon 12**, of the Code of Professional Responsibility and the Lawyer's Oath. Respondent is ordered **DISBARRED** from the practice of law. His name is ordered **STRICKEN** from the Roll of Attorneys.

Let copy of this Decision be: (1) entered into the personal records of Atty. Eligio Mallari with the Office of the Bar Confidant; (2) furnished to all chapters of the Integrated Bar of the Philippines; and (3) circulated by the Court Administrator to all courts in the country for their information and guidance.
