SUBJECT: LIFTING OF SUSPENSION FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW OF ATTY. JULES A. MEJIA

For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the Resolution dated 19 February 2020 of the Court (Special Third Division) in A.C. No. 11024, titled "Aurea Y. Yangca vs. Atty. Jules A. Mejia (Retired RTC Judge of Alaminos City, Pangasinan)," to wit:

Acting on the Report and Recommendation dated January 8, 2020 of the Office of the Bar Confidant (OBC) and considering that respondent submitted a certification dated December 13, 2018 from the IBP Pangasinan Chapter, stating that respondent has ceased and desisted from the practice of law for a period of six (6) months, the Court, upon the recommendation of the OBC, resolves to:

- (1) LIFT the order of suspension meted against Atty. Jules A. Mejia and ALLOW him to RESUME his practice of law; and
- (2) REMAIN EFFECTIVE the order of disqualification from being commissioned as notary public for two (2) years.

The said report and recommendation of the OBC is NOTED.
