SUBJECT : LIFTING OF SUSPENSION FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW OF ATTY. JOSELITO I. FANDIÑO


For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the Resolution dated 24 August 2020 of the Court (Special Third Division) in A.C. No. 6767, titled "Elizabeth Recio vs. Atty. Joselito I. Fandiño," to wit:


The Court, upon the recommendation of the OBC, resolves to:

- (1) NOTE respondent Atty. Joselito I. Fandiño's Motion to Lift Order of Suspension dated February 25, 2020, and GRANT his prayer that he be allowed to resume his practice of law considering that he had already served his suspension and he has complied with the requirements;
- (2) LIFT the Order of Suspension meted against Atty. Fandiño and ALLOW him to RESUME his practice of law; and
- (3) INFORM Atty. Fandiño that his disqualification from being commissioned as a Notary Public shall continue until January 31, 2021. Upon full service of the said disqualification, he is DIRECTED to FILE a similar motion to lift and SUBMIT the necessary certifications from the same courts and IBP Chapter, all of which affirming that he has not been

commissioned as notary public from January 31,
2019 to January 31, 2021.
