**OCA CIRCULAR NO. 33-2021**

**SUBJECT : SUSPENSION OF ATTY. ROBINSON C. VIÑAS FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW FOR SIX (6) MONTHS**

For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the dispositive portion of the Resolution dated 30 July 2019 of the Court (First Division) in A.C. No. 11379, titled "Zenaida B. Gonzales, Complainant, v. Atty. Robinson C. Viñas, Respondent" to wit:

WHEREFORE, the Court AFFIRMS the resolution dated January 21, 2021 of the Integrated Bar of the Philippines Board of Governors, with MODIFICATION that respondent ATTY. ROBINSON C. VIÑAS be SUSPENDED from the practice of law for a period of SIX (6) MONTHS, with a stern warning that a repetition of the same or similar acts will be dealt with more severely.

Let copies of this decision be served on the Office of the Bar Confidant, the Integrated Bar of the Philippines, and the Office of the Court Administrator for proper dissemination to all courts in the country for their information and guidance and be attached to respondent's personal record as attorney.
