SUBJECT : LIFTING OF SUSPENSION FROM THE  
PRACTICE OF LAW OF ATTY. ROMAN J.  
CUISON, JR.


For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the Resolution dated 17 March 2021 of the Court (Special Second Division) in A.C. No. 11866, titled "Gennilyn P. Lamostre vs. Atty. Roman J. Cuison, Jr.," to wit:

Considering respondent's (1) manifestation dated 23 January 2020 that he has returned the full amount of ₱91,595.00 to the complainant; (2) verified motion (for leave of Court to resume practice of law) and compliance filed on 7 October 2020, submitting verified manifestation dated 7 October 2020 submitting certifications from the Regional Trial Court, and the Municipal Trial Court of Davao City, attesting that he has not appeared in court or practiced law from 20 January 2020 to 20 May 2020, and a certification from the Integrated Bar of the Philippines [IBP] Davao City Chapter as additional proof that he did not practice law during the period of his suspension, and (3) the returned and unserved copy of the Resolution dated 4 December 2019 (which, among other matters, found respondent guilty of violation of Rule 18.03 of the Code of Professional Responsibility and suspended him from the practice of law for four [4] months effective upon receipt of the resolution, and ordered to return to complainant the amount of ₱91,595.00 with legal interest of six percent [6%] from the date of

promulgation of the resolution until full payment) sent to complainant at her address on record with notation "RTS, Not Connected," the Court resolves to LIFT respondent's order of suspension from the practice of law, and to GRANT his verified motion for leave of Court to resume practice of law.
