SUBJECT : LIFTING OF SUSPENSION FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW OF ATTY. EDMUNDO S. LEGASPI

For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the Resolution dated 6 October 2021 of the Court (Special First Division) in A.C. No. 10094, titled "Benjamin J. Cruz vs. Atty. Edmundo S. Legaspi," to wit:

The Court further resolves to:

- (1) *LIFT* the order of suspension of respondent Atty. Edmundo S. Legaspi from the practice of law; and
- (2) ALLOW respondent Atty. Edmundo S. Legaspi to RESUME his practice of law and REQUIRE him to file another motion upon the expiration of his disqualification from being commissioned as a notary public on October 18, 2021 with certifications from the courts where he has pending cases and his IBP Chapter, specifically stating that he was not commissioned as a notary public from October 18, 2019 up to October 18, 2021.
