: SUSPENSION OF ATTY. ROBERTO I. ACDA FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW FOR SIX (6) MONTHS AND REVOCATION OF HIS NOTARIAL COMMISSION AND DISQUALIFICATION FROM REAPPOINTMENT AS NOTARY PUBLIC FOR TWO (2) YEARS

For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the dispositive portion of the Resolution dated 22 July 2019 of the Court (First Division) in A.C. No. 8894, titled "Jocelyn S. Acosta vs. Attys. Jose S. Alvarez, Jr., Roberto I. Acda, and Delfin Agcaoili, Jr.," to wit:

findings of fact Considering that the recommendation of the Investigating Commissioner in the attached report and recommendation, as approved by the IBP Board of Governors, are supported by the evidence on record and applicable laws, the Court ADOPTS and ACCEPTS these findings and recommendation to: (i) DISMISS the case against Atty. Jose S. Alvarez, Jr., there being no showing that he violated the Lawyer's Oath and the Code of Professional Responsibility; and (ii) SUSPEND Atty. Roberto L Acda from the practice of law for six (6) months, immediately revoke his notarial commission and DISQUALIFY him from being appointed as notary public for two (2) years for his deplorable laxity in the administration of his office.

There being no motion for reconsideration or petition before the Court, the complaints against Attys. Alvarez and Acda are deemed CLOSED and TERMINATED.
