SUBJECT : LIFTING OF SUSPENSION FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW OF ATTY. RICHARD R. ENOJO

For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the Resolution dated 12 April 2023 of the Court (Special Second Division) in A.C. No. 13211, titled "**Angeles P. Gajunera vs. Atty. Richard R. Enojo**," to wit:

The Court resolves to:

1. **NOTE** and **APPROVE** the manifestation of compliance dated March 20, 2023 and sworn statement of respondent Atty. Richard R. Enojo, and **ALLOW** him to **RESUME** his practice of law;

2. **ALLOW** the Office of the Bar Confidant (OBC) to deposit the ten (10) Banco de Oro Postal Money Orders (Check Nos. 0600052303-0600052312) in the total amount of ₱20,000.00 to the fiduciary account of the Supreme Court in the name of complainant Angeles P. Gajunera; and

3. **DIRECT** the Cashier, Fiscal Management & Budget Office, this Court to safekeep the official receipt of the deposited checks to enable complainant Mr. Gajunera to claim the said checks from the cashier.

The Court **NOTES** the Report and Recommendation dated March 31, 2023 of the OBC.
