OCA CIRCULAR NO. 245-2023

SUBJECT : LIFTING OF SUSPENSION FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW OF ATTY. LUCILLE FE R. MAGGAY-PRINCIPE

For your information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the Resolution dated 15 February 2023 of the Court (Special Third Division) in A.C. No. 12700, titled "Melanio S. Cu vs. Atty. Lucille Fe R. Maggay-Principe," to wit:

ACCORDINGLY, the Court, upon the recommendation of the OBC, further, resolves to **NOTE** and **APPROVE** Atty. Lucille Fe R. Maggay-Principe's Letter dated December 21, 2022, and **ALLOW** her now to **RESUME** her practice of law. She shall be **REQUIRED** to pay a fine in the amount of Two Thousand Pesos (PHP 2,000.00) within ten (10) days from receipt of resolution, and submit to the Court and/or the OBC the Official Receipt issued by the Supreme Court. Failure to pay the fine may result to another administrative case against her.

In view of all the foregoing and for having been filed beyond the reglementary period, the Court **NOTES WITHOUT ACTION** respondent's motion for reconsideration of the Resolution dated June 16, 2021, which suspended her from the practice of law for a period of six (6) months.
