**SUBJECT : LIFTING OF SUSPENSION FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW OF ATTY. RONALDO ANTONIO V. CALAYAN**

For information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the Resolution dated 11 July 2023 of the Court *En Banc* in A.C. No. 8208, titled "Ret. Judge Virgilio Alpajora vs. Atty. Ronaldo Antonio V. Calayan," to wit:

The Court Resolved, upon the recommendation of the Office of the Bar Confidant, to

(a) **NOTE** and **APPROVE** the Compliance with Motion to Lift Order of Suspension and Sworn Statement dated January 27, 2023 filed by respondent Atty. Ronaldo Antonio V. Calayan; and

(b) **ALLOW** the respondent to **RESUME** his practice of law effective upon the filing of the above Compliance with Motion to Lift Order of Suspension and Sworn Statement pursuant to Section 46, Canon VI of the Code of Professional Responsibility and Accountability. In case it is discovered that the respondent made misrepresentations in his Sworn Statement, he shall be subjected to another administrative case and stiffer sanctions.
