**OCA CIRCULAR NO. 317-2023**

**TO : THE COURT OF APPEALS, SANDIGANBAYAN, COURT OF TAX APPEALS, REGIONAL TRIAL COURTS, SHARIAH DISTRICT COURTS, METROPOLITAN TRIAL COURTS, MUNICIPAL TRIAL COURTS IN CITIES, MUNICIPAL TRIAL COURTS, MUNICIPAL CIRCUIT TRIAL COURTS, SHARIAH CIRCUIT COURTS, THE OFFICE OF THE CHIEF STATE PROSECUTOR, PUBLIC ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, AND THE INTEGRATED BAR OF THE PHILIPPINES**

**SUBJECT : LIFTING OF THE SUSPENSION FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW OF ATTY. RODOLFO B. POLLENTE, JR.**

In its Resolution dated 04 July 2022 in A.C. No. 13206, titled "*Juanito Militante v. Atty. Rodolfo B. Pollentes, Jr.*," the Court (Third Division), among others, found respondent **GUILTY** of violating Canon 18, Rule 18.02 and Rule 18.03, of the Code of Professional Responsibility and **SUSPENDED** him from the practice of law for a period of **THREE (3) MONTHS** and **ORDERED** to pay a **FINE** of Ten Thousand Pesos (**₱10,000.00**) for disobeying an order of the Commission on the Bar Discipline of the Integrated Bar of the Philippines from notice of the Resolution.

The Office of the Bar Confidant, in its 1<sup>st</sup> Indorsement dated 16 August 2023, furnished the Office of the Court Administrator a copy of the **Compliance and Sworn Statement** dated 26 June 2023 filed by Atty. Pollentes, Jr.


Pursuant to the guidelines outlined by the Court in its Decision dated 10 January 2023 in A.C. No. 11032, titled "*Re: Order dated 01 October 2015 in Criminal Case No. 15-318727-34, Regional Trial Court (RTC), Branch 49, Manila, against Atty. Severo L. Brillantes*" governing the lifting of the penalty of suspension imposed against members of the Bar, the order of suspension shall be automatically lifted upon submission by the respondent lawyer of such Sworn Statement that he or she has completed the service of suspension<sup>1</sup>.
