## OCA CIRCULAR NO. 329-2023

TO

SUBJECT:

DISQUALIFICATION FROM BEING COMMISSIONED AS A NOTARY PUBLIC FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) MONTHS OF ATTY. MARIA JOHANNA N. VALLEJO

For information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the dispositive portion of the Decision dated 16 March 2022 of the Court (Third Division) in A.C. No. 11219, titled "Spouses Antonio and Josefa Perla Tan vs. Atty. Maria Johanna N. Vallejo," to wit:

ACCORDINGLY, respondent Atty. Maria Johanna N. Vallejo is found liable for violation of Section 3(c) Rule IV of A.M. No. 02-8-13-SC otherwise known as the 2004 Rules on Notarial Practice.

Respondent is **REPRIMANDED** with stern warning that a repetition of the same or similar infraction will be dealt with more severely.

Further, respondent is DISQUALIFIED from being commissioned as a notary public, or from performing any notarial act if she is presently commissioned as a notary public, for a period of three (3) months.

She is **DIRECTED** to **INFORM** the Court, under oath, of the exact date of receipt of this Decision.

In a Resolution dated 08 February 2023, the court NOTED the Compliance dated 01 September 2022, filed by respondent Atty. Maria Johanna N. Vallejo, with the Decision promulgated on

16 March 2022, acknowledging receipt on August 25, 2022 the copy of the said decision.
