## SUBJECT: PARTICIPATION IN THE PREPARATORY ACTIVITIES FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF PUERTO PRINCESA CITY JUSTICE ZONE ON OCTOBER 11-13, 2023

The Justice Sector Coordinating Council (JSCC) composed of the Supreme Court, the Department of Justice, and the Department of Interior and Local Government, will conduct preparatory activities, namely, Resource Mapping, Orientation and Consultation Meeting, and a Development Planning Workshop with the Puerto Princesa justice sector stakeholders to assess the viability of Puerto Princesa City as the next Justice Zone.

A Justice Zone is an area or a locality where the local justice sector agencies identify common problems and solutions to address them. It aims to invigorate coordinative strategies among the institutions, ensure that complex institutional reforms are effectively linked and sequenced, and communicate such measures to the different stakeholders and justice sector actors concerned. As of June 2023, the JSCC has established and operationalized eleven (11) justice zones in Quezon City, Cebu City, Davao City, Angeles City, Bacolod City, Calamba City, Naga City, Balanga City, Baguio City, Zamboanga City, and Tagaytay City.

In this regard, all Puerto Princesa City judges, clerks of court, and branch clerks of court are enjoined to physically attend the following activities:
