
For information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the Resolution dated 01 August 2023 of the Court *En Banc* in A.C. No. 12536, titled "[Formerly CBD Case No. 12-3298] (In Re: Supreme Court [First Division] Notice of Judgment Dated December 14, 2011 in G.R. No. 188376 [Land Bank of the Philippines vs. Federico Suntay as Represented by His Assignee, Josefina Lubrica] vs. Atty. Conchita C. Miñas)," to wit:

The Court Resolved, upon the recommendation of the Office of the Bar Confidant, to

(a) **NOTE** and **GRANT** the Manifestation and Motion to Lift Suspension Order dated June 14, 2023 filed by respondent Atty. Conchita C. Miñas, requesting that the suspension order be lifted and she be allowed to continue her practice of the legal profession in the Philippines; and stating her address, to wit: No. 018 Doña. Corazon Drive, Farconville Subdivision, Phase II, Brgy. San Francisco, San Pablo City, 4000 Laguna; and

(b) **ALLOW** the respondent to **RESUME** her practice of law. In case it is discovered that the respondent made misrepresentations in her Manifestation, she shall be subjected to another administrative case and stiffer sanctions.
