SUBJECT: LIFTING OF THE SUSPENSION FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW OF ATTY. CATHERINE C. CORPUZ-VALENCIA

In its Resolution dated 07 September 2022 in A.C. No. 9907, titled "Rey O. Arzadon, et al. vs. Atty. Catherine C, Corpuz-Valencia," the Court (Third Division), among others, SUSPENDED her from the practice of law for one (1) year.

The Office of the Bar Confidant, in its 1st Indorsement dated 23 November 2023, furnished the Office of the Court Administrator a copy of the <u>Manifestation of Compliance and/or Letter-Request for the Lifting of the Order of Suspension</u> dated 16 November 2023 and <u>Sworn Statement/Certificate of Service of Suspension</u> dated 15 November 2023 filed by Atty. Corpuz-Valencia.

Pursuant to the guidelines outlined by the Court in its Decision dated 10 January 2023 in A.C. No. 11032, titled "Re: Order dated 01 October 2015 in Criminal Case No. 15-318727-34, Regional Trial Court (RTC), Branch 49, Manila, against Atty. Severo L. Brillantes governing the lifting of the penalty of suspension imposed against members of the Bar, the order of suspension shall be automatically lifted upon submission by the respondent lawyer of such Sworn Statement that he or she has completed the service of suspension.¹

RE: Lifting of the Suspension from the Practice of Law of Atty. Catherine C. Corpuz-Valencia

Accordingly, insofar as the Court's Resolution dated 07 September 2022 in A.C. No. 9907 is concerned, the therein imposed suspension from the practice of law of Atty. Catherine C. Corpuz-Valencia is deemed LIFTED.
