SUBJECT: LIFTING THE DISQUALIFICATION FROM BEING COMMISSIONED AS NOTARY PUBLIC OF ATTY, ELOISA M. ACERON-PAPA

For information and guidance, quoted hereunder is the Resolution dated 26 April 2023 of the Court (Third Division) in A.C. No. 10231, titled "Oscar M. Baysac vs. Atty. Eloisa M. Aceron-Papa," to wit:

ACCORDINGLY, the Court, upon. The recommendation of the OBC, resolves to:

- (1) GRANT respondent's Motion to Lift Judgment of Disqualification (Notarial Practice) dated July 1, 2019, informing this Court that she has already served her one (1) year suspension from the practice of law, and that the same was lifted in the Resolution dated January 31, 2018, and that the service of her notarial disqualification ended on October 21, 2018 and praying that an order be issued lifting her two (2) year disqualification from being commissioned as Notary Public on account of her full service thereof; and
- (2) LIFT the order of disqualification from being commissioned as a notary public against Atty. Aceron-Papa. She may now file her petition for notarial commission before a competent commissioning court of jurisdiction.

The said OBC Report is NOTED.
