## OCA CIRCULAR No. 13-2024

## SUBJECT: JUSTICE ZONE ANNUAL PLANNING AND TEAM BUILDING WORKSHOP

The European Union through the Justice Sector Reform Programme: Governance in Justice (GOJUST) has organized and will conduct the "Justice Zone Annual Planning and Team Building Workshop" for the twelve (12) justice zones from November 2023 to January 2024.

This activity aims to: (1) situate the accomplishments of individual justice zones based on the 5 thematic areas; (2) review the issues identified during the individual online sessions, identify and prioritize which ones will be addressed collectively as a justice zone towards achieving higher maturity levels of justice zones by the end of 2025; and (3) further strengthen institutionalization and standardization of the justice zones through the 3Cs (coordination, collaboration, and communication) based on the conduct of team building activities.
