OCA CIRCULAR NO. 109-2024

TO : THE COURT OF APPEALS, SANDIGANBAYAN, COURT OF TAX APPEALS, REGIONAL TRIAL COURTS, SHARIAH DISTRICT COURTS, METROPOLITAN TRIAL COURTS, MUNICIPAL TRIAL COURTS IN CITIES, MUNICIPAL TRIAL COURTS, MUNICIPAL CIRCUIT TRIAL COURTS, SHARIAH CIRCUIT COURTS, THE OFFICE OF THE CHIEF STATE PROSECUTOR, PUBLIC ATTORNEY'S OFFICE, AND THE INTEGRATED BAR OF THE PHILIPPINES

SUBJECT : LIFTING OF THE SUSPENSION FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW OF ATTY. HERMINIA A. BATI

In its Resolution dated 27 March 2023 in A.C. No. 13716, titled "*Rose Mary B. Dela Cruz v. Atty. Herminia A. Bati*," the Court (Second Division), among others, **SUSPENDED** her from the practice of law for six (6) months and revocation of her notarial commission and disqualification from reappointment as a notary public for two (2) years.

The Office of the Bar Confidant, in its 1st Indorsement dated 3 April 2024, furnished the Office of the Court Administrator a copy of the **Sworn Statement** dated 30 January 2024 filed by Atty. Bati.

Pursuant to the guidelines outlined by the Court in its Decision dated 10 January 2023 in A.C. No. 11032, titled "*Re: Order dated 01 October 2015 in Criminal Case No. 15-318727-34, Regional Trial Court (RTC), Branch 49, Manila, against Atty. Severo L. Brillantes*" governing the lifting of the penalty of suspension imposed against members of the Bar, **the order of suspension shall be automatically lifted upon submission by the respondent lawyer of such Sworn Statement that he or she has completed the service of suspension.**¹

RE: Lifting of the Suspension from the Practice of Law of Atty. Herminia A. Bati

Accordingly, insofar as the Court's Resolution dated 27 March 2023 in A.C. No. 13716 is concerned, the therein imposed suspension from the practice of law of Atty. Herminia A. Bati is deemed **LIFTED**.
