OCA CIRCULAR NO. 98-2024

TO

SUBJECT: LIFTING OF THE SUSPENSION FROM THE PRACTICE OF LAW OF ATTY. FLORENCIO A. NARIDO, JR.

In its Resolution dated 21 November 2016 in A.C. No. 11487, titled "Shirley Dal-Castañeda v. Atty. Florencio A. Narido, Jr.," the Court (Second Division), among others, SUSPENDED him from the practice of law for one (1) month.

The Office of the Bar Confidant, in its 1st Indorsement dated 18 March 2024, furnished the Office of the Court Administrator a copy of the <u>Sworn Statement of Compliance</u> dated 23 November 2023 filed by Atty. Narido, Jr.

Pursuant to the guidelines outlined by the Court in its Decision dated 10 January 2023 in A.C. No. 11032, titled "Re: Order dated 01 October 2015 in Criminal Case No. 15-318727-34, Regional Trial Court (RTC), Branch 49, Manila, against Atty. Severo L. Brillantes governing the lifting of the penalty of suspension imposed against members of the Bar, the order of suspension shall be automatically lifted upon submission by the respondent lawyer of such Sworn Statement that he or she has completed the service of suspension.¹

Accordingly, insofar as the Court's Resolution dated 21 November 2016 in A.C. No. 11487 is concerned, the therein

imposed suspension from the practice of law of Atty. Florencio A. Narido, Jr. is deemed LIFTED.
